
We help students in crisis, families with adolescents struggling with any number of emotional challenges including:

Therapy

We have Master-level licensed therapists trained in various therapeutic interventions, including Dialectal Behavior Therapy (DBT) and Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) to foster social and emotional growth.

OUR ADMISSIONS PROCESS

STUDENT SUPPORT CENTER (SSC)







The SSC space has been converted into a sensory room. The sensory room is equipped to help students enhance concentration, attention and alertness. Optical, acoustic and tactile stimuli in the room helps students learn to self-soothe, redirect their focus and deal with real-life encounters in a healthy way.

SSC provides brief therapeutic intervention, by allowing students the opportunity to process an incident that is immediate in a safe place where they can readjust and then return to their classroom.

OUTDOOR LEARNING CENTER

LOGOS goes beyond the traditional classroom. Every student has a unique learning style and the Outdoor Learning Center is a great opportunity for student-centered approach and hands-on learning. Students participate in fieldwork, learning expeditions, projects and case studies. Our instructors also offer Gardening and Conservation-Ecology as elective classes.

ATHLETICS

CHOICE-BASED ART PROGRAM

2020 Summer Intensive Program

June 8 – July 16, 2020 Tuition for Virtual 5 week program:

High School

I class (.5 credits), with therapy included = \$1,275 (includes free elective Art or PE for .5 credits)

2 classes (1 credit), with therapy included =

\$1,550 (includes free elective Art or PE for .5 credits)

3 classes (1.5 credits), with therapy included =

\$1,750 (includes \$75 savings instead of elective)

Middle School

Middle school, with therapy included = \$1,550


