Grab-N-Go Lunches (11am -1pm on Monday, Wednesday & Friday)

We will continue to serve two Grab & Go lunches per child on each day for Monday and Wednesday and one lunch on Friday in the TCHS Student Parking Lot on Temple City Blvd. **Please drive through and remain in your car.** Any students who need to walk to the lunch service will be given special directions for picking up lunch. If a parent can show the student's school ID card, we will serve the lunch to the adult on behalf of the student in case the student cannot be present. No ID card is necessary if the child is present. **Please keep in mind that on Monday, May 25, 2020, we will not be serving lunch in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.** Lunch service will resume on Wednesday, May 27, 2020.

Grade Reporting Preference – Deadline 5pm on Friday, May 15, 2020

As a reminder, the deadline for TCHS students and Oak Intermediate Algebra and Geometry students to choose Credit / No Credit in a class is this Friday, May 15, 2020 at 5pm. If a student does not select the CR/NC option for a given class, the grade in that class will default to the letter grade for the class. Any student requesting letter grades in all classes should NOT submit this form.
