#### **Dear AACS Eagle Families,**

By God's good grace, we are all adjusting to a new normal, and while soon our state will begin to reopen, we are keenly aware that masks and distancing in public areas will remain part of daily life for the foreseeable future. I want to thank you for your support and active involvement as our community adjusts to the remote and virtual learning environment. You, the teachers, and the students do not labor in vain; our God has promised to hold our feet firm so we may remain steadfast.

#### **Enrollment & Budget**

Much of the regular school business is continuing all around us. Leadership-board, cabinet, and school--is meeting and planning for year-end events and the coming months. This past August, we began the academic calendar with 930 total students enrolled. Presently, we have just over 800 students enrolled for the coming school year. While there are more than 100 potential students in various stages of the application process, enrollment projections are lower for 2020-2021 due to public health and economic uncertainties. So as not to put any undue burden on the budget for the next school year, we are planning accordingly and pursuing funding made available to nonprofits through the federal and state government's CARES ACT. We will be prepared for the start of school in August, praying for teachers and students to return to our four campuses while planning for all possibilities.

#### **Spring Calendar**

As for the spring calendar of events, I have some updates to share. The MIAA and the IAAM officially canceled the athletic seasons at the Upper School. All spring sports at the Middle School are canceled, too. Senior Practicum presentations, the candlelight service, and graduation--as well as K-12 award ceremonies, yearend chapels, and class celebrations--are being reimagined virtually with the flexibility to adapt once public health experts and government officials announce how and when it is safe to congregate. To that end, our website calendar already has some "save the date" yearend events from each campus posted. Look for more yearend events information coming from your campus leaders in May. Please keep all students, especially our seniors, in your prayers as they grieve the loss of traditional rites of passage and daily in-person interactions with teachers, mentors, coaches, and friends.
