Dear NHS Class of 2020 Students and Families,

As you all are aware, plans are underway for our Northbrook High School Class of 2020 outdoor graduation ceremony that will take place at Tully Stadium on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Our highest priorities as we plan this special event for you and your families are safety, security and adherence to all health protocols and requirements set forth by Governor Abbott's Executive Order and the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

While more information will be forthcoming, we know you want to begin making arrangements for your family. Here are some details we can share at this time:

- Each graduate will receive a maximum of four non-transferable tickets for family members who wish to attend. We are abiding by TEA's guidelines to limit the number of participants to a level that can be managed in the outdoor venue to maximize social distancing, both during the event and during entry and exit.
- Our graduation ceremony will be live-streamed on the SBISD website. We recommend that individuals considered "at risk" (for example, elderly individuals, individuals with compromised immune systems, anyone who has been in contact with a COVID-19 patient, etc.) should not attend the ceremony and should, instead, view it online.
- Gates at Tully stadium will open for guests at 6:00 p.m. More information will be forthcoming specific to graduate arrival and check-in.
- Only one car per family, please.
- We expect it to be very warm outside. Attendees should dress accordingly.
- Bags, regardless of size, will be prohibited. This means no purses, backpacks or other bags may be brought into the stadium, unless required for health reasons. Under these circumstances, a small clear bag must be used. Additional information about other prohibited items will be forthcoming.
- Prior to entering the ceremony, students and attending family members will asked by an SBISD employee to indicate if they have any Covid-19 symptoms, including the following:
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Chills
  - Repeated shaking with chills
  - Headache
  - Muscle Pain
  - Sore Throat
  - Loss of taste or smell
  - Diarrhea
  - Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
  - Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19
