

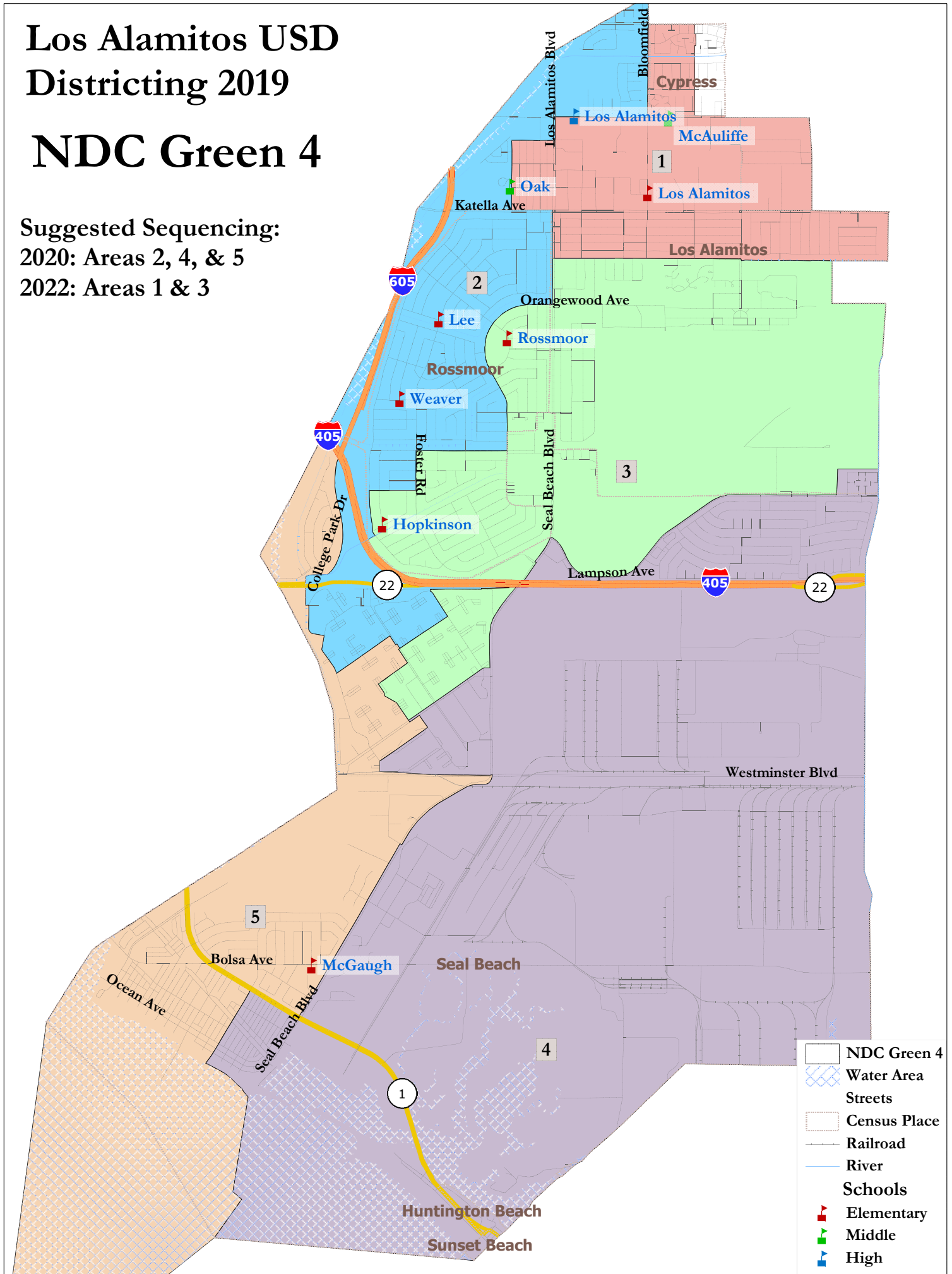
Los Alamitos USD Districting 2019

This map meets the legal $\pm 10\%$ deviation requirement for equal population in each trustee area and includes a majority non-white Area 1 in the northern part of the District that links Old Town Los Alamitos, Apartment Row and the portion of Cypress in Los Alamitos Unified.

Green 4 Map Summary — Focus Map (Map was Revised December 16, 2019)

As in the original Green map, Leisure World is divided between four areas in this map. This map is similar to Green 3 Map and also includes the move of Parkewood from Area 2 to Area 4, but it redistributes schools across the trustee areas by moving Rossmoor Elementary into Area 3, so that Rossmoor and Hopkinson Elementary are in Area 3, and Lee, Weaver and Oak Middle School are in Area 2. Los Alamitos Elementary, Los Alamitos High and McAuliffe Middle School in Area 1; and McGaugh Elementary in Area 5. Area 2 includes the northern and western parts of Los Alamitos and Rossmoor but does not include College Park West, which is linked to central Seal Beach in Area 5. Area 4 includes all of College Park East along with the eastern portion of central Seal Beach and Surfside. 13th Street west of PCH divides Old Town Seal Beach between Areas 4 and 5. Trustee Davidson is in Area 1. Trustees Boyer and Hill are in Area 3. Trustees Cutuli and Russell are in Area 5, with Areas 2 and 4 vacant.
