Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer for Free and Reduced Eligible Students

The federal Families First Coronavirus Response Act of 2020 provides benefits, referred to as Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT), to families of school-aged children who would have otherwise received free or reduced-priced meals if it were not for school closures. A family will receive the benefit amount of \$5.70 for each school-aged child in their family for each day school has been closed since March 16, 2020, **IF** the student was eligible for free or reduced-price meals **PRIOR** to school closures. For purposes of P-EBT calculations, June 12, 2020, is being used as the last day of the school year.

The Department of Health and Human Services anticipates beginning to mail the EBT cards around June 5, 2020. All households will receive a separate mailing that describes P-EBT and provides households with contact information for any P-EBT-related questions.
