Draw your favorite toy from observation



Write out all the letters of the alphabet in order. Now think of a song with a title that starts with the letter "A" (ex. America). Then "B", "C", through the whole alphabet. You can play this as a game with others. Take turns with each person thinking up the next letter/title.

Create a comic strip showing the beginning, middle, and end of a story.



Get some paper and drawing supplies. Listen to a piece of music with no words. Draw as you listen.




Invent a new kind of candy. Design the wrapper for it.



If you have at least 2 people, the first person thinks of a song everyone playing knows. Then they hum the song - no words allowed! When the other person guesses the song it becomes their turn to hum a song.

Draw a maze. Have someone at home solve it.



Listen for interesting or mysterious sounds. Draw a picture of an imaginary source of the sounds (a new machine or undiscovered animal, etc) Don't forget to give it a name.



Hide something in your house and draw a treasure map for someone at home to use to find it.



Make a list of all the people in your home and their favorite songs (if you don't know, ask them). Listen to as many of the songs as you can. BONUS: Make it into a dance party!

Go outside and create a mandala out of natural materials. Leave it for somebody to find.



Your favorite musician is releasing a new album!
What is the album called? Design an album cover with the title and name of the musician.



Cut out facial features from magazines and arrange them to create funny collage portraits.



Find an item in your home that you can make at least 2 different sounds with (ex. Make sounds using a bottle of water by tapping it, shaking it, or blowing across the top). Make a song with your new instrument.

Write a poem and create an illustration to go with it.
