Do you have a favorite book you've been reading? Or maybe you're like us in that you have MANY books you love. When you meet with your teachers this week, tell them about your favorite book you're currently reading.



This upcoming week brings many fun activities for your family to explore together. Our focused theme this week is on "Essential Workers" and Memorial Day.

In math, students will work with place value, number sense and solving problems finding "fewer than" and

"more than". Students will also calculate elapsed time and have discussions (Number Talks) around mathematical thinking.

In writing, students will be stretching out important parts; writing with phonics and using proper punctuation. Students will be using chapter books to track their understanding chapter-by-chapter, and then thinking of the lesson learned by the end of the book.

In Science/Social Studies, students will be learning a little more about the importance of essential workers in our own Renton community, and how they can show appreciation in their own community! There will be several ideas of how to show your gratitude for their service. You will also learn important information about an upcoming holiday called Memorial Day.

We also ask that students take some time in the next few weeks to listen to the rest of the nominated Children's Choice Picture Book Award books that they didn't finish in Library with Ms. Mann, and vote on their favorites:
