**Day 1:** Remember the staff and bingo board you made last week? Today, you are going to use it to play bingo by yourself. Drop the paper and then cover the correct space for bingo! Can you get one bingo? How about 2 bingos? Can you create your own bingo pattern?

**Day 2:** Play note bingo with a family member or friend. If you have permission, play note bingo with a classmate either virtually or on the phone. If virtual, you can show what line or space the note lands on. If by phone, you can just tell each other.

**Day 3:** Grades 2-5: Create a 16 beat rhythm pattern and clap it for someone. Remember to use quarter notes, quarter rests, half notes, and paired eighth notes in your rhythm.

Grades K-1: Clap this rhythm pattern. Once you know it, teach this pattern to a friend or family member. Can you change the pattern around?
