Review of Current Goals

Chadli Bodily

2019-2020 Goal Review

- **Goal 1:** Decrease the number of students scoring “below proficient” on Reading Inventory by 2%
 - **Current Data:** Read 180 shows Lexile growth of 92.51 and Reading Extension growth of 60.36
- **Goal 2:** Maintain 9th grade “on track for graduation” at 95.5% and increase career readiness course enrollment by 2%
 - **Current Data:** 96.2% of 9th grade currently “on-track”. Career Readiness courses increased by 4.2%
- **Goal 3:** Increase students who have “personally been rewarded for good behavior” by 5% and increase students monitoring and reflecting on academic progress from 2.64 to 2.54
 - **Current Data:** 355 students received a High-Five award. 100% of students recognized with HOPE Week. Classroom reflection has increased from 2.26 to 2.50 and 69% of students participate in Study Skills class with personal academic tracking and individual teacher mentoring.
- **Goal 4:** Learners receive differentiated instruction regularly throughout all classes.
 - **Current Data:** Increased from 2.52 to 2.57.

School Visions & Goals for 2020-2021 School Year

Chadli Bodily

- **Goal 1:** Increase “Growth” & “Proficiency” for students with disabilities by 2% on the TSI indicator score from .341 to .36
 - **Plan:** Increase co-teaching opportunities, continue reading remediation courses, & utilize Legacy Learning for academic support
 - **Additional Funding Necessary:** \$ 45,000 for 5 full year productivities to reduce class sizes and incorporate double blocking for remediation classes. (Minimum 37,000). \$7,500 stipend costs for teachers who provide support during Legacy Learning.
- **Goal 2:** 80% of students will set weekly academic goals that allow them to reflect on their academic progress and work with a faculty mentor to achieve academic growth.
 - **Plan:** Establish mentoring time for all students, provide mentor training for all mentoring faculty, provide student liaison for at-risk populations
 - **Additional Funding Necessary:** \$4500 each teacher to receive sub day for mentor training
- **Goal 3:** Increase the percentage of teachers implementing differentiated and personalized learning opportunities by .5 point on the Evaluate Davis C1 measures (from 1.73 and 1.50 to 2.23 and 2.0).
 - **Plan:** Provide collaboration days for teachers to work on student differentiation pathways within curriculum, increase student technology accessibility, provide professional training opportunities for teachers to increase instructional strategies, & provide Instructional coaching for faculty
 - **Additional Funding Necessary:** \$8,000 for instructional coaching for staff
