

## Elementary Art 3rd through 5th Grade eLearning Guide- Week 9

### Choose one of the art lessons that inspires you to CREATE.

#### “I Wear My Sunglasses”

How about making your very own set of CRAZY glasses? They are super simple to make and you can have HOURS of fun with them.



#### “Sunglasses Self-Portrait”

Put sunglasses on and look in the mirror. Draw what you see. Now, draw where you would like to be reflecting on the glass part of the sun glasses.



#### “Seascapes”

Think about what you see at the beach. Did you know that a work of art of the ocean or sea is called a seascape? Basically it is a landscape of the beach and sea. What would you see at the beach? Maybe beach umbrellas, children playing in the sand, swimmers, surfers, boats, crabs, and beach balls? What is your favorite memory from visiting the beach?

- Add 5 things you might find on the beach, 3 things in the water, and 2 things in the sky to make your Seascape.

#### “Flip Flops”

Trace the bottoms of your shoes on paper. Create your own flip flop design.



#### “A Day at the Beach”: Sand Castles of Peace

The beach is a place for fun and sun. Swimming in the surf and jumping the waves.

But, no day would be complete until you dig in the sand and sculpt your very own sand castle.

Can you draw your own castle of peace?

What tools would you need to build a sand castle?

What would you find on the beach to add to your castle?



#### “Message in a Bottle”


**“Design a Candy Bar”**

Make up a new kind of candy bar! Be creative! What would you combine together to make a wonderful first bite? How would you design the wrapper to stand out?




**“Draw a Sandwich”**
