Delta is a cooperative STEM program of the Kennewick, Pasco, and Richland School Districts. Seats are limited; enrollment is by lottery. <u>Due to the special nature of</u> <u>the program, students and families must commit to enrolling for a full year to</u> <u>ensure students remain on track for graduation. Once a seat is accepted for the</u> <u>year, the student may not be permitted to transfer to another high school program</u> <u>until the end of the school year.</u>

I understand that discipline infractions will be treated under the policies of the school district where I am enrolled. If I fail to fulfill my responsibilities, I understand I may be placed on a behavior contract and/or exited from the Delta program.
