

Elementary Self-Paced Summer Learning Overview

Families:

This packet is designed to offer a fun and engaging way to practice learning over the summer. This packet includes 5 Learning Boards. Each Board is self paced providing 8 activities that can be done in any order containing math, literacy and other skill practice. The activities can be completed independently or may need your guidance. Your child/ren can strive to complete as many of the activities as possible over the course of the summer. The lower right hand grid has links to websites and resources. Throughout the summer weeks, explore the websites and resources that will provide even more ideas for fun learning opportunities.

There is a built-in reading incentive. Each day students read for 20 minutes, they get to color in a section of the image in the lower left hand corner. Once each Learning Board is completed, plan a quick celebration like letting them choose what's for dinner or playing a game together.
