

BTW Summer Math

Summer math is a way to keep your math skills in check away from school so that you are ready for your next math course in the fall. Teachers will not be taking the summer math as a grade, but instead will be giving incentives to those who complete the summer math work. Instead of a physical packet, summer math work will be administered through the website DeltaMath. Below is information on how to access the summer math work and the incentives based on courses.

- If you currently have a TPS email, we require you to use this email to sign up for DeltaMath
- Make sure you have the correct First and Last name that will be on Powerschool.
 - This is how we will identify you will receive an incentive

There are three different levels of summer math work. Please join the math account that fits your course for next fall. If you join a different level you may not receive an incentive in your math class.

Level 1: Going into Algebra 1 in Fall 2020

- Teacher Code: 989769

Level 2: Going into Geometry or Algebra 2 in Fall 2020

- Teacher Code: 155181

Level 3: Going into any course past Algebra 2 in Fall 2020

- Teacher Code: 356033

- You can access DeltaMath on a computer or on your phone.
 - If you are working on the summer math on your phone please note that your submit button for a problem is behind the keyboard. This means you need to minimize the keyboard to submit your answer.

Summer Math Start and End Date:

- You will have access to the summer work starting **Monday May 18th**.
- You must complete your summer work by **Tuesday August 18th** at 11:59 pm (this is the day before school starts).
- While you are working through the summer work you can come and go as you please. You do not have to complete all the work in one sitting.

Incentives for completing the summer math work:

- Algebra 1: Replaces a quiz grade
- Geometry: Replaces a quiz grade
- Algebra 2: Incentive is left up to the teacher
- Algebra 3: Incentive is left up to the teacher
- Pre-Calc: Incentive is left up to the teacher
- Math IBSL: Extra Credit on an assessment
- Math IBHL: Extra Credit on an assessment
- AP Stat: Incentive is left up to the teacher
- AP Calc AB: Extra Credit on an assessment
- AP Calc BC: Incentive is left up to the teacher
