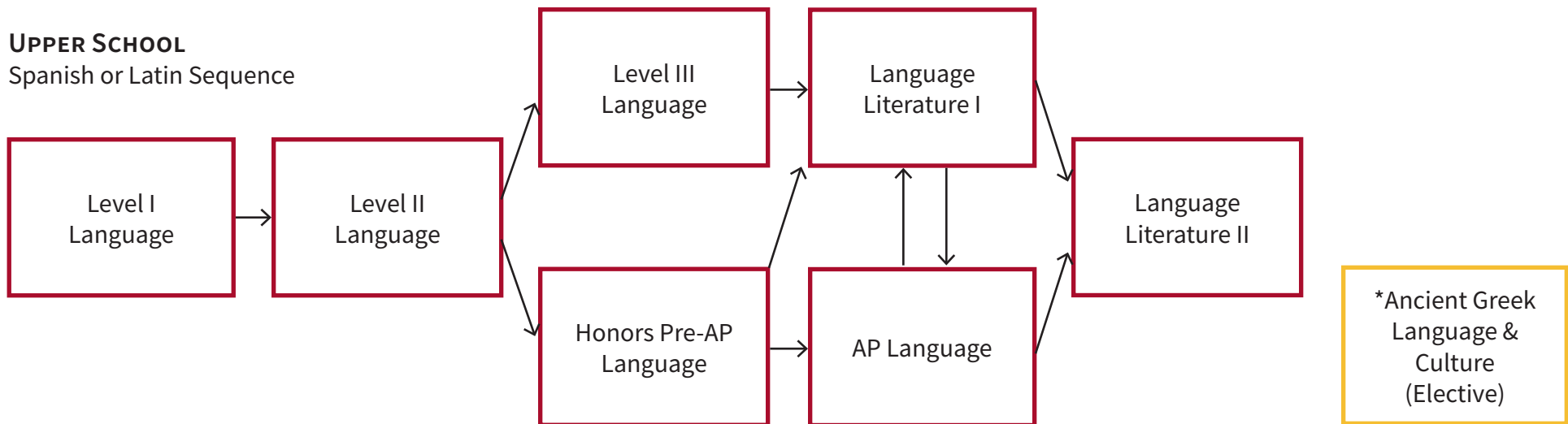
LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT Curriculum Pathways

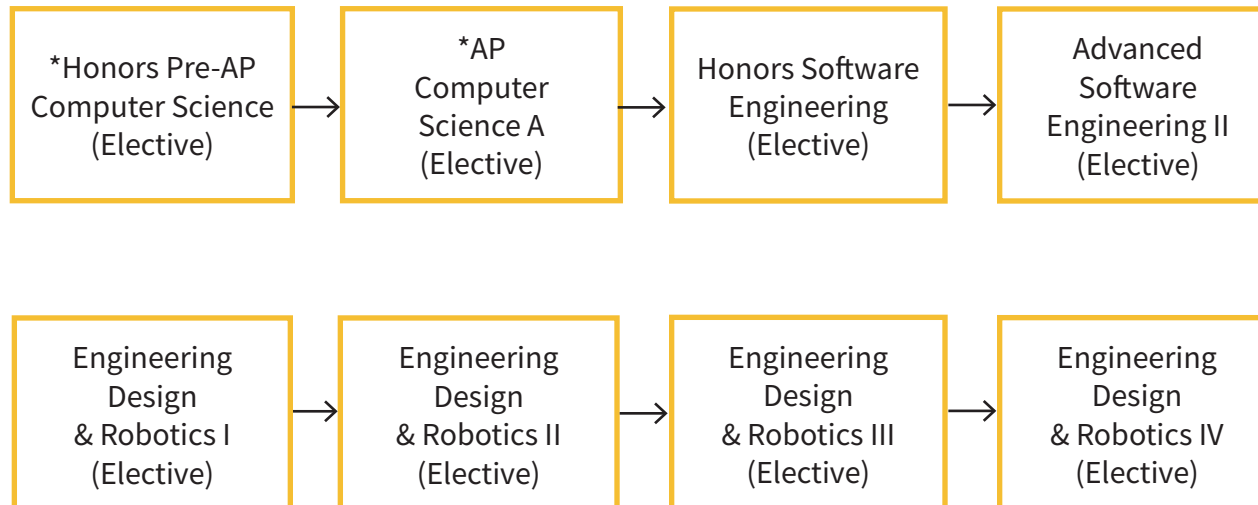
Notes: Conceptual Physics, Biology, Chemistry are required of all students. After completion of Biology, students may take more than one science course in any single year. Advanced Placement (AP) courses are available only after the standard course in that subject has been successfully completed, and at the discretion of the instructor and Head of Academics. Biology and Chemistry will prepare students for the SAT II tests in those subjects and follow the pre-AP curriculum as defined by the College Board.
