Early Entry Programme

Q: Who is the Early Entry Programme for?

1. Students who want to study medicine, veterinary medicine and dentistry at British universities.
2. Students who want to study any subject at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge.
3. Students who want to study certain courses at Imperial College, London.

Early Entry Programme

Q: Why is the Early Entry Programme necessary?

1. British medical, veterinary and dentistry school, all courses at Oxford and Cambridge, and some at Imperial College, London, require a greater depth of subject knowledge and skill than the baccalaureat can provide.

Early Entry Programme

Q: Who can join the Early Entry Programme?

1. Any student who plans to apply to study medicine, veterinary medicine or dentistry at a British university; anyone who plans to study any subject at Oxford or Cambridge; anyone who plans to study certain subjects at Imperial College, London.

Early Entry Programme

Q: Are there any conditions for being accepted onto the Early Entry programme?

A: Yes. Early Entry courses are demanding, and we therefore look at:

1. Previous academic record (DNB, notes, bulletins).
2. Willingness to take on extra work (eg, EPQ).
3. Teachers' recommendations.
4. Engagement with the subject.
5. Emotional resilience and ability to cope with a heavy workload.

Continue Building a Strong Portfolio during Première

KEY POINTS

- Importance of 1ere marks / exams!
- Portfolio preparation for art courses
- Early Entry Programme for Oxbridge / Med / Imperial
- University Application Prep Week (Workshops, Alum & HE Presentations...)
- Subject specific supra-curricular ex: coding, conferences, MOOCs, reading, show interest!
- Work Experience mandatory (1 year) - Med, Vet and Dentistry
- Prepare / pass IELTS (results good 2 yrs)
- EPQ in your area of interest (UCAS Points)

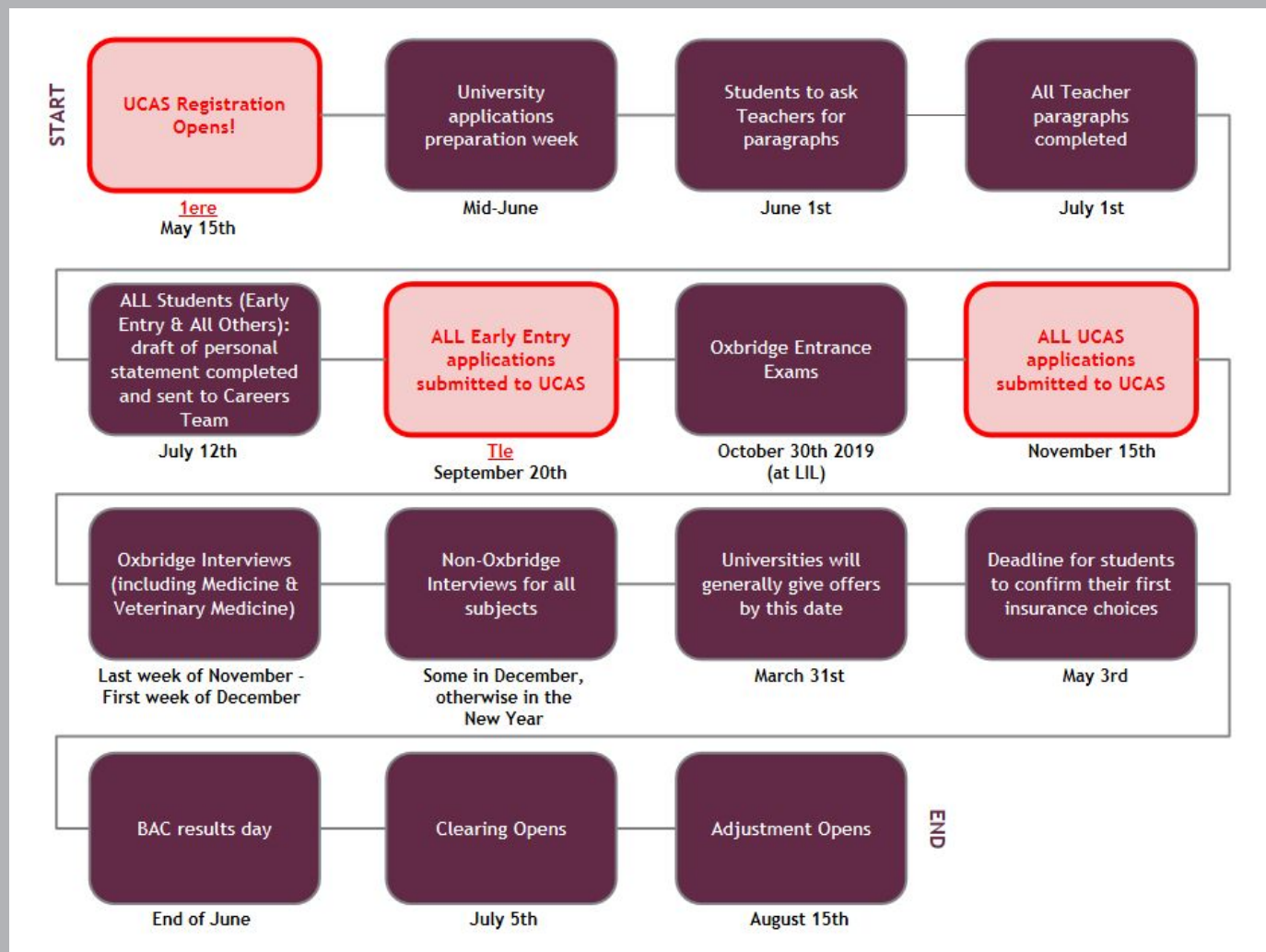

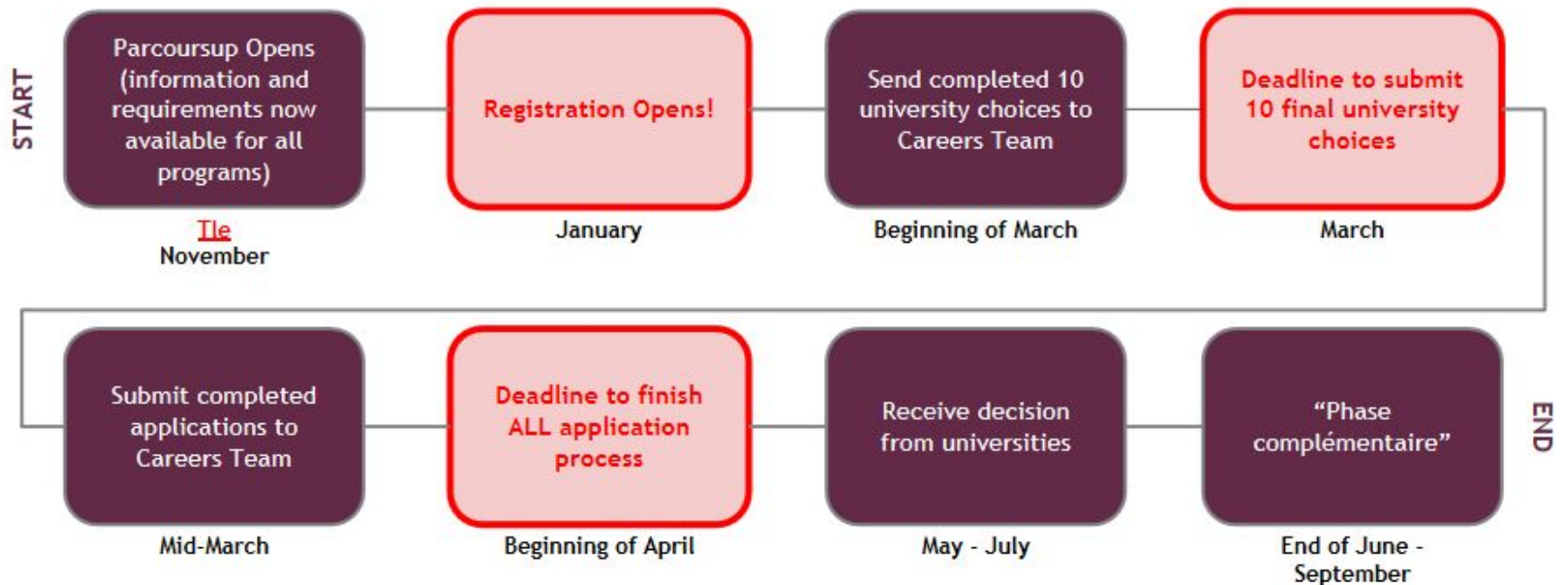

Timeline for UK University Applications

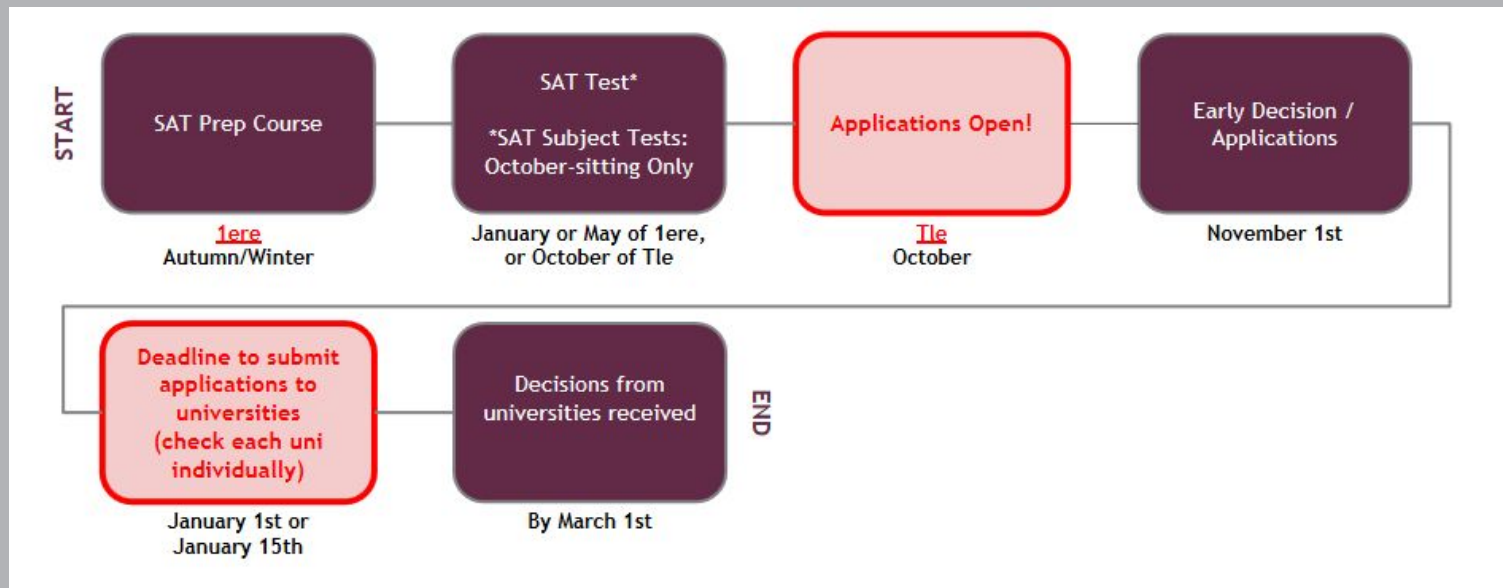


Timeline for France University Applications

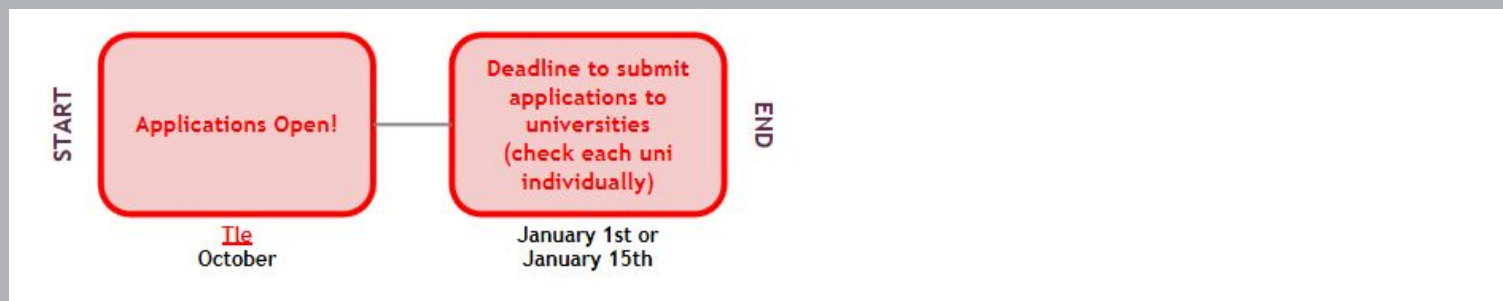


Timeline for U.S. and Canada University Applications
