What are Summer Nutrition Programs?

The Summer Nutrition Programs provide nutritious meals at no charge to all children ages 1-18 at participating sites. To participate, just show up. You don't need to register or get meal tickets and no one will ask for proof of income or age. This program is for kids only and adults are not allowed to eat off a kid's tray. The ability to buy adult meals or extra items will not be allowed.
