We are all looking forward to seeing you tomorrow! Based on our safety policies, we will be observing the following social distancing guidelines:

The clean-out schedule is based on English classes. This will break up the alphabet and limit the number of students allowed in the school at a given time. All students will enter through the front entrance and be greeted by Nurse Paquette. She will distribute health records and t-shirts. Students will then be able to take pictures in the courtyard with Headmaster Thornburg and Brother Puccio. Students may want to wear their college sweatshirts or school dress for the photos.

Students will follow the directions on the floor and walls which will clearly indicate how to get to the lockers. For social distancing practices, the hallways and stairwell will be marked as "one-way." Students are asked to bring their own bags to gather their belongings.

You are asked to comply with the following guidelines for Tuesday morning:

- Take your Temperature in the morning. If it is 99.1 or above -STAY HOME
- If you have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days-STAY HOME
- If you or anyone in your home has been ill within the past 14 days with the following symptoms:
 - 1. Sudden loss of taste or smell
