

## **Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi**

You can use the Internet from your Chromebook anywhere there's a Wi-Fi network that's compatible

## First, turn on Wi-Fi

In the lower right corner of your screen, check the network Wi-Fi icon 🔍. If you see the network Wi-Fi signal off icon 🔪, click it to turn Wi-Fi on. Your Chromebook will detect nearby networks.

## Then, connect to a Wi-Fi network

## Connect to an open network

Open networks don't have a lock on them and don't require the use of a password. To connect to an open network:

- 1. In the lower right corner of your screen, click the network Wi-Fi icon  $\mathbf{V}$ .
- 2. Choose an open network to connect to.

Connect to a network that requires a password

Secure networks are marked with the Wi-Fi lock icon van and require additional information before you can connect. To log in to a secure network:

- 1. In the lower right corner of your screen, click the network Wi-Fi icon
- 2. Click the secure network you'd like to connect to. A box will open.
- 3. Enter the password for that network.
- 4. When prompted, choose "WPA," then select either WPA-1 or WPA2-Personal security. The WPA-2 setting offers more security than WPA-1. WEP isn't recommended.
