TRANSITION ACADEMY REDMOND

- Each week students receive their weekly plan and materials via email.
- 91% of our students are actively participating in their program with a minimum of one reciprocal contact. Roughly half of the students are making contact daily and another quarter of the remaining students are making contact multiple times a week.
- 1:1 tutoring or instruction
- 4 students currently receive ongoing additional 1:1 instructional support from paraeducators and/or their teacher throughout the week.

TRANSITION ACADEMY KIRKLAND

- Each week students receive their weekly plan and materials via email.
- 9 of 15 of our students are actively participating in the remote learning.
- 2 families have determined that they don't want weekly support and work with staff when needed.
- 1 family refused services.
- 3 families are too overwhelmed to access services currently and transition academy staff are working with these families on supports and problem solving.


TA-REDMOND TEAMS Video Group Sessions:

- 4 groups that meet on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons each with 4-8 different groups of students attending each session
- 1 daily morning meeting with 7 regularly attending
- 70% of our students are participating in one or more of the video group offerings
- Groups topics vary from sharing updates, recipes, reading or watching recommendations, playing games, to discussing social skills and how to adapt to current limitations.
- Paraeducators and our SLP join sessions to support the meeting



Independent Life Skills Activity

- Students are given a checklist of activities that they can do from home or in the community with their families
- Families are providing with recommendations for activities and supports to accomplish them.

TRANSITION ACADEMY KIRKLAND & NW CENTER

- 10 Students for 2019-20
- 14 Students for 2020-21
- Graduates have been hired at Fred Meyer, Safeway, Trader Joe's, Value Village, Compass (Microsoft Campus Food Service), Arena Sports, Chuck E. Cheese. Most are on a hiatus from work during social distancing, but our grocery workers have maintained dedicated work schedules.

Graduates who have not yet been hired have been working hard with Sarah, our embedded employment specialist via video chat to practice interview skills and sharpen work skills.

- 14 students for 2019-20
- 16 students for 2020-21
- 2 graduates employed in paid work
- 12 students placed in volunteer work sites (only students in grocery store placements are still working)
