Although the state is slowly reopening in phases amid this coronavirus pandemic, **MISD administration has decided to cancel all in-person summer programs.**

The decision to solely provide online summer courses was made due to the current social distancing guidelines that are still in effect to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus. The limitations and restrictions in place for in-person summer programs would not be feasible with the large amount of participants that the district usually anticipates for its various camps and classes.

MISD is working with state, local and health officials to create a plan that will allow students to safely return in the fall. No decision has yet been made, but be assured that **the district does not plan to implement a year-round (intersessional) calendar**, which is an option presented by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).
