The dog wanted to chase a cat. Can you play a chasing game? Maybe What's the time Mr Wolf or Stuck in the Mud. You could make up your own rules too.



50 things to do before you're five

Can your child put their shoes on on their own? Do they know which feet they go on? Can they do up velcro tightly? Can they put on socks and tights without help?





Talk about the legs on the insects. Can you use some of these words
