Priority Deadline: May 31

The Early Start Scholarship is a summer program designed to help *first-time college students* needing developmental coursework. Students who meet the criteria for the program will receive tuition and book rental scholarships for summer courses.

In order to be eligible for the Early Start Scholarship, a student must not have attended college since receiving a diploma or GED, must show need for developmental level coursework in at least two areas (English, math, and/or reading) and be enrolled full-time for the following fall.

During the first summer of enrollment, students will receive scholarships for developmental courses only, so that they are better prepared for college-level work in the fall.

Early Start Scholarship students will be eligible to receive a summer scholarship for college-level coursework during their second summer of enrollment if they maintain a 2.0 GPA.
