We hope that you enjoyed the activities focused on essential workers and Memorial Day! As you know that holiday is on Monday, so we have prepared just four activities for literacy, math and science/social studies for the coming week. The theme for those days is "Zoos," with an emphasis on Tigers (of course! 😊).



During this week, you will be thinking about tigers in two zoos. You will watch videos that show the tigers in their habitats. While you watch, we would like you to make observations about the way they look and their environment. You will use those notes to compare the tigers in both zoos. The week ends with a fun read aloud and a STEM activity.

You will continue thinking about zoos and animals while completing math activities. You will solve math addition and subtraction problems using more than one strategy to show your thinking. You will compare the speeds of different animals and solve word problems about people visiting the zoo. Which animal would you like to go see at the zoo?

Reading lessons will be about what to focus on while reading non-fiction books. You will continue to practice decoding troublemaker words. In writing, your activities will be about revising your writing to make it even better!
