Dates: June 2, 3 & 4

Times: 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm

Drive into the bus lane in front of Sunrise on Cedar Avenue. A greeter will meet you at your car. We will get the name and grade of your student and a runner will bring your items to your car.

Pick up: Yearbooks, award certificates, classwork, medication from Health Office, Locker contents from hall & phy ed lockers

\*Locks for hall lockers will be sent home. Students should label their lock with the combination and save for next year

Drop off: Books from the Media Center & classrooms, textbooks, school-owned instruments (if not returning to Sunrise), Chromebooks & chargers (if not returning to WBL schools)

Keep at home: Students who will be continuing with WBL schools should keep their Chromebooks & chargers at home over the summer
