

#### Why should my child participate?

- 1. Did you know, research shows that . . . the more you read, the better reader you will become, reading increases your vocabulary, helps prevent learning loss over the summer, improves listening skills . . . and much, much more!

#### What books can my child read?

Students can read anything! Just keep in mind that *students must read* **Bible** *pages in addition to the General books in order to earn an ice cream party.* \***Bible** pages include . . . reading from the Bible, Daily Devotions, Children's Bibles and Bible Stories.

10 Bible verses are equal to 1 page

\***General** books include . . . magazines, family read-alouds, non-fiction (folktales, tall tales, fables, fairy tales, books on animals, science, art, music, sports, hobbies, etc.), poetry, jokes, fiction, history, and biography.
