Reminder: Last Week of School Timeline for Students & Last Day to Turn in Assignments

All assignments from the week of May 18-May 21st will be due on Tuesday, May 26th at 8:00am. Teachers will then run grades and calculate Semester 2 grades with AND without the A6 average. We will choose the higher Semester 2 average. This will make sure that A6 can only improve Semester 2 grades. We will then include Semester 2 grades into the cumulative GPA.

Summer Meal Distribution

YES Prep will continue to distribute meals during the summer on the same schedule that has been followed during the closure. Meals can be picked up from the Brays Oaks Campus on Mondays and Thursdays between 11:00a.m. and 1:00p.m. Please do not come to pick up meals if you or anyone in your vehicle is feeling sick.



During meal distribution, you can receive breakfast and lunch for multiple days. Note that you must have at least one child under the age of 18 with you to receive meals. If you cannot bring your child with you, you can present their student ID at meal pickup.

Parents WITHOUT a survey confirmation, will NOT be able to obtain food. Social distancing will be enforced so please follow the signs and make sure car trunks are popped open when asked. Procedures for Returning Items:

On the day designated for your grade-level, students/families will enter the Westbrae Gate and drive around the front of the school to the side cafeteria door. A staff member will approach your car to help collect materials. Do not get out of your vehicle. At this time, only seniors will be given the opportunity to collect items from their lockers. All other students will be given the opportunity at a later time. Students will be receiving more information via Teams, and phone calls will be sent out.
