**LUNCH BUNCH:** Lunch Bunch runs from **12:00 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.** as an extension to our half-day camps, and provides an opportunity for Frederica Academy Summer Programs to provide lunch for your child. Lunches will include a choice of sandwich, two sides, and a cookie. Campers are also welcome to sign up for the Lunch Bunch hour and bring their own lunch.

**FA Summer Programs will not be accepting any walk-up registrations for the duration of our camps in the summer of 2020.** Because of the limited number of registrants allowed, all campers must register before the camp begins.

## Little Knights (Ages 3-4)

Little Knights camp is a half-day themed camp running from **9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.** for our 3 and 4 year old friends with an option to stay for lunch. Each week, our camp will highlight a new theme that incorporates age-appropriate reading, crafts, hands-on activities, games, and songs. You can find each theme listed weekly below. Additionally, our Little Knights will participate in a Water Day on-site every Friday. Parents will receive a weekly newsletter via email prior to the beginning of each week to outline all the fun that we will have! Campers must be 3 years old by June 1, 2020, and be fully potty trained.

## Camp Knights (Grades K-5)

Camp Knights is back and packed with adventure! Camp Knights can be offered as a full day camp running from **9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.** or as a half-day camp running from **9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.** or **1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.** for any camper in rising K-5th grades. Campers will be grouped by grade (K-2 and 3-5) and will participate in our NEWLY-revamped, STEAM-focused activities tailored to their age group. STEAM includes science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics. These weekly activities will provide hands-on exploration opportunities while incorporating games and outdoor play. Each week our Camp Knights will have a special movie day that accompanies their weekly theme and will participate in an on-site field trip to explore adventures from our community. Additionally, each week Camp Knights will have a Water Day on-site. Registered parents will receive a weekly newsletter via email that outlines our adventure-packed itinerary prior to each week.

## Courses for Credit

Our courses for credit are open to all students that fall within the appropriate grade range. These courses also offer a unique opportunity for our Frederica Academy students to earn a .5 credit. Each of the following courses run from **9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.** Monday through Friday for a total of 3 weeks. If a student is interested in enrolling in each of the three camps, the instructors have agreed to work out a schedule so that all course requirements may be fulfilled. ### **THE STORY OF PRESIDENTS & THE 2020 ELECTION** (Rising 9th-12th grades)

- This 3-week course will be offered as an online course this summer. Through the course, the students will learn about past presidents while exploring the upcoming 2020 election.

### **TURN OFF YOUR VOICE & USE YOUR HANDS** (Rising 9th-12th grades)
