As you read this book, you can choose where the story goes! Follow your choices until the very end. How many endings can you find?



Reading assignment:

1) **Read at least TWO versions** of the book all the way to the end. You get to choose which versions you want to read!

Written assignment:

- 1) You will create a two-page (minimum) scrapbook ~ un album de recortes.
 - a) In this scrapbook you will include a variety of elements that reflect your understanding of the **TWO different versions** of the story you read. This means you will have TWO scrapbook pages, one for each version of the story.
 - b) You will personalize your scrapbook with your summary, your opinions, your artwork, perhaps some photos or images. You can do this work by hand on paper with colored pencils or markers, or you can do this on the computer, using Jamboard: https://edu.google.com/products/jamboard/

For your each one of your TWO scrapbook pages:

- 1) Include a summary of the story you read (6-8 sentences).
- 2) Include visuals that illustrate or reflect the story. Include a minimum of 4. These could be drawings, images, photos, etc.

1) **Lee DOS versiones** del libro hasta el fin. ¡Tú puedes escoger las versiones que quieres leer!

La tarea escrita:

- 1) Vas a crear un álbum de recortes de dos páginas (mínimo).
 - a) En tu álbum de recortes, vas a incluir una variedad de elementos para reflejar tu conocimiento de las **DOS versiones diferentes** del cuento. Por eso, tendrás DOS páginas en tu álbum de recortes.
 - b) Además, vas a personalizar esta tarea con tu resumen, tus opiniones, tu arte, tus fotos, etc. Puedes hacer esta tarea a mano en papel o por

Para cada de las DOS páginas de tu album de recortes:

- 1) Escribe un resumen del cuento (6-8 oraciones).
- 2) Para ilustrar y revelar tu conocimiento del cuento, incluye dibujos, imágenes, fotos (un mínimo de 4).
