



SENIOR SCHOOL - SPRING PLAN FOR SCHOOL & CAMPUS ACCESS

Monday, May 25, 2020

While our current model of emergency online learning will remain in place until the end of Senior School classes on June 5, 2020, we are opening the campus for those students who have asked to continue their online learning in our building during the last week of classes. The schedule for those boys only is posted below.

Our [online academic timetable](#) will continue for the remainder of this year. This timetable, as well as adjustments, can be found on the [Covid-19 section](#) of the Vancouver College website.

Note that we will be following all WorkSafe protocols, as summarized in our COVID-19 Safety Rules. On their assigned day, boys who are continuing their online learning on campus must be dropped off on Hudson Street at 8:20 am. From there, they will be directed to an assigned classroom, where they will work individually on their online classes, as well as eat lunch. There will be a mid-day supervised break. Dismissal will be at 3 pm, and we ask that you pick up your son from Hudson Street at that time.

Please do contact me directly if there is to be a change in your son's attendance on his specified day.

- Monday, June 1 - Registered Grade 11 students
- Thursday, June 4 - Registered Grade 10 students
- Friday, June 5 - Registered Grade 12 students

We are also planning for a number of special activities that will bring all of our boys back on campus at least one last time this school year:

- All boys will be invited to return textbooks, empty lockers, pick up yearbooks, and bid farewell to their teachers for the summer. Please refer to the schedule below for the details of arrival times.
- Grade 12s will participate in our modified in-person graduation ceremony on June 16-18. Specific details to follow shortly to our Class of 2020, as we continue to plan around what is both safe and practical.
- Students who would benefit from on-campus learning will continue to be invited back in small groups, while following all safety protocols during those times. These groups include students who would benefit from increased structure and supervision, as well as those in classes that require special equipment or facilities. Either I or specific teachers will reach out to communicate these opportunities; feel free to contact me directly if you would like your son involved.

Senior School Final Visit Plan - Each group of 30 boys will be allotted one hour to drop off textbooks and pick up yearbooks in the cafeteria, empty their lockers, and say good-bye to teachers as per the schedule below. Please drop off your sons on Hudson Street, where they will proceed initially to the Dining Hall, and then back to the Senior School building before departure.
