Getting Started at Bellevue College

Student Central, located in Building B, is where advisors answer questions, resolve issues, and guide you to your next steps. Student Central houses the following departments to best support your success:

Welcome Center: Shares about Bellevue College, the programs, and its services. They also support you to apply for admissions to the college and complete other entry processes.

Financial Aid: Hosts FAFSA and WASFA workshops, helps you understand your financial aid award (loans, grants, and work study), and provides information on additional funding resources.

Enrollment Services: Provides services related to enrollment, registering for classes, transferring credits, official transcripts, enrollment verification, and more.

Placement and Testing Services: Offers a variety of options for students who need English and math placement prior to registering for classes, as well as tests and proctoring services.

Evaluations and Graduation: Supports you to transfer credits to the college, apply to graduation, and give you all the details you need to participate in commencement.

Academic Advising: Offers advising to current and returning students who are earning Associate's and professional/technical degrees and certificates.
