RESPONDING TO COVID-19

What follows is our commitment to our community. We will...

- 1. Be in this together.** A safe return requires universal cooperation and commitment. Pace takes seriously the health risks associated with COVID-19 and expects all community members to do the same.
- 2. Consult the experts.** In addition to our nursing staff, we have assembled an advisory group of experienced healthcare professionals within our community to guide our policies and practices. We are committed to following guidelines set by public health authorities.
- 3. Provide testing.** All Pace employees—including teachers, coaches, support staff and on-campus service providers—will be tested. We ask that families consider testing as well and follow the advice of their physicians.
- 4. Implement daily temperature checks.** All individuals who enter campus must have their temperature taken. Students, faculty or staff exhibiting symptoms of illness must stay home.
- 5. Prioritize those at high risk.** Pace will take steps to ensure the health and safety of those documented to be medically fragile.
- 6. Maximize social distance.** Consistent with recommendations from public health officials, Pace will implement social distancing recommendations to the best of our ability.
- 7. Practice healthy habits.** All members of the Pace community will commit to hand washing, practicing good hygiene and, when appropriate, wearing their own face coverings. Hand sanitizers and extra face coverings will be accessible throughout campus, depending on availability.
- 8. Limit visitors.** We will dramatically decrease the number of visitors, including parents, allowed on campus.
- 9. Stay put.** We will pause all student travel, including field trips and Isdell Center for Global Leadership study tours.
- 10. Clean. Clean. Clean.** Cleanstar will continue to employ state-of-the-art cleaning techniques and use environmentally friendly disinfecting products manufactured by Green Klean.
- 11. Focus on food safety.** Our new Food Service partner, Flik, is a leader in institutional food preparation and service. We will work with Flik to ensure food safety, sanitation and healthy serving practices.
- 12. Increase security.** We will implement tighter controls for entering our campus.
- 13. Follow GHSA guidance.** We will abide by the Georgia High School Association's guidelines for interscholastic sports and competition, while implementing additional safeguards of our own.
