Dear Class of 2020 Graduates and Parents,

We cannot express how very proud we are of our 2020 graduates and remain hopeful that they will have their opportunity to "walk the stage" and enjoy a traditional graduation ceremony in mid-June.

As promised, we submitted our plans to the Diocese Catholic Schools Office for approval. **Dependent upon the Bishop's blessing**, our plan is to livestream the Baccalaureate Mass and hold an evening graduation ceremony on Bemis Field the next day. These events would take place on June 17 and 18.

We communicated our desire to possibly host a prom and/or senior picnic for our graduates, but the state restrictions will not allow us to do that

If we receive permission to hold our traditional commencement ceremony there will be strict guidelines that we must adhere to:

- Safe distancing measures and health safety requirements.
- Limiting attendees to two guests per graduate
- Restricting close gatherings
- The ceremony cannot exceed 45 minutes
