- **Before arriving at school:**

- All students and employees will be required to have daily temperature checks.
 - For students, this will need to be done each morning at home before heading to school.
 - All employees will be screened on arrival to campus.
 - It is very important that any student or employee with a temperature of 100.4 or above, or who is experiencing symptoms of illness, should remain at home for at least 48 hours, and can only return when showing no signs of fever or illness without medication
- All students and staff will need to bring face masks to school. Families will need to provide clean, cloth face masks for daily use, and students should have a spare mask in their backpack.

- **If a student develops a fever or symptoms of illness during the day**
 - they will be escorted to a designated place away from other students and staff.
 - Parents will need to pick up their child within an hour.
- **If there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 on our campus**
 - SSFS will follow health official guidelines regarding reporting and contact tracing.
 - If there has been broad exposure, the School may need to close a division, or the campus, and return to a virtual learning mode for a period of time.
- Throughout the campus there will be **ongoing sanitization and decontamination procedures** in the classrooms, including
 - Continuing to reinforce the need for frequent hand washing, and reminding students to wash and sanitize their hands regularly throughout the day.
 - We'll also be thoroughly wiping down and sanitizing desks and other hard surfaces, both between classes, and at the end of the day.
- Even taking all reasonable measures to mitigate virus transmission, **potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus cannot be completely eliminated**, and this virus may remain with us for some time yet. However, if we all work together in a mindful way, we can help minimize the risks. **Please do your part when we return to school** by
 - **Making sure your child does NOT come to school if they are feeling unwell** in any way
 - **Ensuring that your child's vaccinations are up to date** before coming to campus.
