Kyle Kovach – Elementary School

- 1st Cycle of Interim Assessment – On the first round of Interim Assessments 50% of 3rd graders projected to score Met/Exceeds in Math and 58% of 4th graders.
- Red Ribbon Walk and Hispanic Heritage Parade – Multiple Families participated in these activities.

Stephen Hampton – Middle School

- 1st Round of Interim Assessments – 15% Increase in Math and ELA
- Curriculum Night and Awards Day – Math and ELA teachers did a model lesson for parents so they could see the curriculum in action.

 - 1st strategy does not work solutions – critically analyze

- Public Hearing – November 8, 2018 – Zoning hearing for permission for Triumph Pro Soccer Team to play 1st Season on Legacy’s Soccer Field. Inviting community to come and be informed. The team can play up to two seasons here.
- Annual Gala – Raised \$146,000; Necklace designed and donated by Llyn Strong raised \$8,100.
- Current Enrollment – 1405
- 18 Month Federal Grant Review – Review will be the end of December to decide if Legacy Early College needs a 3 years old-4 years old program. The program is designed to enroll 110 for each grade.
