Activity:	<b>Silly Picture Prompts for writing</b>
Materials:	Pencil, paper
Skills targeted:	Handwriting and written language skills
Instructions:	<p>Open the link below to view the various pictures. Have your child choose a picture and use that picture to generate writing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Young or pre-writing students (preschool, kindergarten) – talk about the picture with your child. Ask questions (who, what, where, how, why, etc).</li> <li>• Early writers (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade) – write a sentence or two about what they see in the picture.</li> <li>• Writers (3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade) – work on paragraph writing skills. Modifications:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. See above for different grade/skill level ideas.</li> <li>2. Print the picture if able, or have your child view the picture on the computer.</li> <li>3. Ask your child questions to help them think of ideas to write.</li> <li>4. If writing a paragraph, use a graphic organizer or checklist to organize ideas (such as topic sentence, 3 detail sentences, conclusion sentence).</li> </ol>

Activity	Paper Clip Fun!
Materials	Paper clips, toilet paper tubes, paper
Skills Targeted	Finger dexterity, finger strength
Instructions:	<p>1. Put paper clips together to make a chain. Turn that chain into numbers or letters!</p>  <p>2. Use paper tubes to decorate with paper clips!</p>  <p>3. Add eyes and put paper clips on strips of paper to make caterpillars!</p>  <p>4. Put paper clips all around paper to make a border. Draw a picture in the middle!</p>



Modifications:

You can come up with other fun ideas! Bigger paper clips will make this easier, smaller lips will be more difficult. Have fun!
