The National Latin Exam is a test typically given to approximately 150,000 students in all 50 states, and in 20 countries around the world. The test covers a general knowledge of Latin grammar and vocabulary, reading comprehension skills in Latin, mythology, Roman culture and history, and derivatives.

- From the National Council of Teachers of English program Recognizing Excellence in Art and Literary Magazines, *The Walrus* was awarded a First Class ranking. Only 47 magazines on the national level earned this highest honor.
- From the National Scholastic Press Association, *The Walrus* received First Class Rating with marks of distinction in design.
- From the Columbia Scholastic Press Association, or CSPA, *The Walrus* received two awards.
 - For the individual merit written critique from CSPA, The Walrus received a Gold Medal with All-Columbian Honors for Essentials, Verbal, and Visual.
 - At the national competition level, the CSPA honors top student publications chosen from member schools. Crowns are selected for overall excellence in a head-to-head comparison with other publications. During Crown consideration, publications are judged on their excellence as shown by their design, photography, concept, coverage and writing. This year, *The Walrus* was one of 21 magazines awarded a Silver Crown at the national level.
