Suggested Process	 Ask an adult for 2 dry beans, 2 ziploc bags, tape and 2 wet paper towels. Place each bean inside a folded, wet paper towel. Place each paper towel inside its own ziploc bag. Using tape, hang up one ziploc bag in the sun and one in the shade. Make a prediction which will grow faster. Wait to see which bean sprouts! Record your observations.
