Below are some extension activities for this unit! Although these activities require more planning and materials, they also allow for more creativity and free exploration!



- Unicorn Foam Sensory Bin: Use dish soap, water, cornstarch, and food coloring to make this fun sensory bin! Add plastic toys to make it even better! See how here: https://viewsfromastepstool.com/unicorn-soapfoam-sensory-bin/
- Rainbow Sensory Writing Tray: Have your child draw a beautiful rainbow on a sheet of paper. Lay the picture they drew on a cookie baking sheet and cover with salt. Gross Motor

• The Gruffalo: Act out the Gruffalo with your child! Practice the movements that the different animals in the story do. This is a great way to get moving while practicing re-telling a story!

ELA

 Feed the Dragon: Have your child create their own dragon - either by drawing or creating a 3D dragon with a box or paper bag. Encourage them to be creative! Then make small "tacos" by cutting out half circles from light brown/tan paper. Write letters on the "tacos" and have your child "feed" the dragon while reading the letters on each taco!

Math Concepts

- Patterns: Nothing says imagination like rainbows! Use strips of different colored paper to crate rainbow patterns! See how many different types of patterns you and your child can come up with!
- Sorting: Use those same strips to sort by color or size! This combines important cognitive skills with fine motor skills!
