This is the final letter for the current school year detailing updates to our district's At-Home Academic Enrichment Activities Plan.

### **Plan for Students in Good Academic Standing**

Based on the revised grading and promotion/retention policies we shared on April 27<sup>th</sup>, (you may review this information by [clicking → HERE](#)), students in good academic standing have sufficient grades and have made sufficient progress to successfully complete the 2019-20 school year. Parents of students without access to a technology device or internet may request to pick up a new S.W.A.G. Pack by calling your child's school. These optional additional online resources and S.W.A.G. Packs are designed to provide learning opportunities for students until the last day of school.

### **Plan for Students NOT in Good Academic Standing**

If your child is not in good academic standing based on our [revised grading and promotion/retention policies](#), you should have already been contacted and made aware of your child's status by a school official. These students will be required to complete one or more course projects which may include the new online resources and/or S.W.A.G. Packs or another course specific assignment detailed by the school.

There is a small number of parents which schools have not been able to contact to make them aware of their child's academic status. If you are not sure of your child's status, please contact your child's school as soon as possible. The majority of the students in question are enrolled at Woolfolk Middle School.

In closing, we know that the last few months of the school year has been challenging for many. Nevertheless, we are deeply appreciative for your cooperation, flexibility, and understanding. We are in the beginning stages of planning for possible summer learning opportunities and our plan for re-opening schools in the fall.
