

**Message to all parents (reopening plans)**

I hope that you have had, and are continuing to have, a good half term , and that you are continuing to keep healthy.

You will be aware that, following our publication of draft plans before half term, the Prime Minister has subsequently announced that Year 10 and Lower 6th are not allowed to return to school until Monday 15th June at the earliest.

Therefore, although the school will go ahead with the plans for Year One (2nd June), Reception (3rd June) and Year 6 (4th June) [parents with children in any of these years will hear more details directly from FPS], the arrangements for Year 10 and Lower 6th are being pushed back. We will be drawing up our new plans, in light of the latest Government guidance in the next week, with a view to publish it no later than Friday 5th June.

Remote Learning will, of course, continue. There is no intention to extend the summer term beyond the current end of term date (3rd July) , although we are looking at some increased provision for next academic year, particularly for those year groups facing public examinations in 2021. There will be further thoughts in relation to this when I confirm the plans for the last part of this term.
