CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

South Hartford Conveyance & Storage Tunnel

(Hillcrest Ave., West Hartford)

Starting Tuesday, May 26th, the Metropolitan District (MDC) and their contractor Empire Paving will be working on Hillcrest Ave to continue construction activities for the South Hartford Conveyance and Storage Tunnel (SHCST), which is part of the Clean Water Project.

Work will include establishing construction work zones, crane assembly, and installing sheeting using a vibratory hammer. Other work related to the project will also continue; such as survey and monitoring. All work will primarily take place in the street and public rights-of-way. No disruption to your water/sewer or other utility services are anticipated at this time. While the work is taking place, temporary changes to traffic patterns will be in effect but access to driveways and traffic flow will remain.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and until all social distancing restrictions are lifted, we will be utilizing various outreach methods including mailings, emails and phone calls to limit in-person contact. Project work hours will be Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM, with weekend work as needed.
