Dear Parents,

Incoming Fifth Grade students are required to read three books over the summer. One book is required for all students, and no substitutions may be made. Students may choose the remaining two books. Below is a list of suggested books compiled by the Fifth Grade teachers. The children, however, are not restricted to the books on the list. We recognize that students have diverse interests and varied reading abilities, so we strongly recommend that students choose books that are written at an appropriate reading level. If you would like help in selecting books for your child, please contact your child's reading teacher.

The school year will begin with a discussion of the required book, along with accompanying assignments and projects. All summer reading and summer reading assignments must be completed by the first day of school.

## REQUIRED READING

<u>The One and Only Ivan</u> by Katherine Applegate Ivan is an easygoing gorilla. Living at the Exit 8 Big Top Mall and Video Arcade, he has grown accustomed to humans watching him through the glass walls of his domain. He rarely misses his life in the jungle. In fact, he hardly ever thinks about it at all. Instead, Ivan thinks about TV shows he's seen and about his friends Stella, an elderly elephant, and Bob, a stray dog. But mostly Ivan thinks about art and how to capture the taste of a mango or the sound of leaves with color and a well-placed line. Then he meets

Ruby, a baby elephant taken from her family, and she makes Ivan see their home—and his own art—through new eyes. When Ruby arrives, change comes with her, and it's up to Ivan to make it a change for the better.
