# Coming back to school in a bubble!



## Welcome back!!

#### **VERY IMPORTANT**

You must only use the gate that has been assigned to your year group to enter and exit the premises.

- Nursery— Pedestrian Entrance on the side of the main gate
- Reception & Year 1—Main gate
- Year 6—KS2 pupil path entrance (pupils only)

Your bubble will have some space inside and some space outside. It will be all yours.

None of the children in the other bubbles will come into your bubble space, and you won't go into their bubble space.

## Can you remember how to wash your hands?




This will make sure that we all start our day with clean and healthy hands.
