Actions we are taking at Mount Kelly to keep us safe after reopening:

- Reviewing, amending and publishing our Resumption of Normal Working Practice Policy
- Training for staff and pupils
- Regular communication and briefings for staff, pupils and parents
- Airport collection and quarantine/reintegration arrangements for overseas pupils
- Remote learning to continue for pupils who cannot return to Mount Kelly
- Remote whole School and Prep assemblies delivered to classrooms and Houses
- Ensuring all required social distancing measures are reasonably applied
- Displaying clear signage and visual instruction
- Controlling access to areas in main buildings
- Establishing dedicated entry and exit routes to main buildings
- Distance indicators provided in main passageways
- Social distancing for meals and in boarding Houses
- Sanitation stations established throughout the School
- Regular temperature checks
- Controlled play and free time
- PPE provided as per Government instruction
- Face masks provided on request
- Sport provision appropriate to social distancing
- Supervision areas for isolation if required
- Maintaining the usual round of health, safety and safeguarding checks
- Planning fire drills to take account of social distancing
- Ensuring security and access control systems are fit for purpose
- Refreshing systems for reporting unsafe practices
- Rigorously ensuring cleaning procedures are appropriate
- Reviewing laundry procedures to ensure safety
- Reasonable adaptation of school transport for social distancing
- Half term accommodation for overseas pupils as required
