District The Oleantangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. Oleantangy Local Schools is ranked in the top 4.1% of all school districts in the state of Ohio.

School & Faculty The district opened its third high school, Orange High School, in 2008-09 as a result of rapidly growing enrollment. Oleantangy Orange High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school (grades 9-12) with a present enrollment of 2063 students. There are 492 students in the class of 2019, which will be the school's ninth graduating class. Orange High School has 112 certified staff. Of these, 88 have earned a Master's degree or beyond.

Graduation Requirements The curriculum at Orange High School is comprehensive including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2019, twenty-two credits will be required.

Specific requirements include elective courses and the following required course of study:

Honors & Advanced Placement Courses Honors courses are available in Algebra II, English 9, English 10, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, World History, Advanced Placement courses are offered in Art History, Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Computer Science A, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Environmental Science, French Language, German Language, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Music Theory, Physics I, Physics C: Mechanics, Psychology, Research, Spanish Language, Seminar, Statistics, United States Government and Politics, United States History, and World History. Each instructor's syllabus has been audited and approved by the CollegeBoard.

College Credit Plus (CCP) College Credit Plus courses are weighted and are specified on the transcript with the college/university name, department abbreviation and course code.
