Grab-N-Go Lunches (11am -1pm on Monday, Wednesday & Friday)

We will continue to serve two Grab & Go lunches per child on each day for Monday and Wednesday and one lunch on Friday in the TCHS Student Parking Lot on Temple City Blvd. **Please drive through and remain in your car**. Any students who need to walk to the lunch service will be given special directions for picking up lunch. If a parent can show the student's school ID card, we will serve the lunch to the adult on behalf of the student in case the student cannot be present. No ID card is necessary if the child is present. **Our last day of lunch service will be Wednesday, June 10, 2020.** No summer food service will be provided.

Returning-Student Registration for Next School Year

As summer nears and the end of the school year brings us back together in drive-through form, our team wanted to let you know, as of right now, our 2020-2021 school year returning-student registration days (in August) are scheduled to be virtual and not onsite. The Aeries system will be ready for the mandatory data confirmation that parents need to complete in the beginning of July. When you receive communication that it is open, please follow the steps to complete this process and more information about the school year will be offered at the time of this data confirmation process.

Planning for Next School Year Continues

I truly appreciate the useful feedback from the previous parent survey and countless parent informative emails.
