**Action Items**

The Board approved the Consent Agenda, including approval of the Agenda, January 29th Minutes, Gifts to the District, and Surplus Items lists. Notices of resignation from David

McKenzie and Thuynga "Nikky" Barr were accepted.

The Board approved the recommendation to hire Mr. Edward "Ed" Villarreal as the District's Safety Coordinator, welcoming him to the District Administrative Team.

Douglas ESD Assistant Superintendent, Analicia Nicholson, presented the ESD's proposed 2020-21 Local Service Plan. The Board then approved the ESD Resolution in support of the collaboratively-created local series plan.

Resolution 19-20-13: Bond Resolution Ballot Title, was unanimously adopted by the Board.

The Board reviewed RFP 19-677 Food Service Management Contractors, and directed administration to proceed with notification of Intent to Award, followed by the required protest and response periods.

Policies approved for Second Reading and Adoption included the following:

- ◆ AC: Nondiscrimination; and
- ◆ AC-AR: Discrimination Complaint Procedure.

Revised Policy KG-AR: Use of High School Facilities, was approved for First Reading.

A request to purchase and install security cameras at the middle schools and high school was approved. Prior to June 30th, the District will expend approximately \$55,000 for security cameras to be provided by REECE Complete Security Solutions for installation at our secondary schools.

**Student Leadership Report**

RHS Leadership students Mikayla Sanguins and Elizabeth Wilson recapped current activities including preparing for the annual Arts Assembly on Wednesday, February 19th and upcoming Mental Health Week. Last week students celebrated Counselor Appreciation Week. More than twenty students placed First in the FBLA Skills Conference. RHS Robotics Club will be hosting the Robotics Super Qualifier this Saturday. The opening night for "Curious Savage" performances will be Thursday, February 20th.

Students are fundraising to support relief efforts due to the wildfires in Australia.
