# Staff Recognition

Melrose Elementary School Teacher, Karla Heath, was presented with the Crystal Apple Award with the inscription, "A Teacher Who Invests in us all, Students, Staff and Families".

#### Action Items

The Consent Agenda was approved, including approval of the Agenda, Minutes of the February 26th Meeting, and a Surplus Items listing. There were no hiring recommendations or notices of retirements to report.

The Board approved a Bid Award to purchase 75 Aironet Wireless Access Points from Ednetics, Inc. in the amount of \$11,472.00 after eRate funding. Technology Coordinator, Gary McFarlane, shared that this is Phase III of the project to install wireless access points in all classrooms. The primary focus of this phase will be to install equipment in classrooms at Roseburg High School.

#### Student Investment Account Grant Application

District Teaching and Learning Director, Michelle Knee, presented an overview of the Student Investment Account (SIA) Plan, accompanying budget and the expected four outcomes:

- 1. Increased graduation and attendance rates;
- 2. System to support socialemotional needs for students and adults;
- 3. All students will demonstrate typical or higher growth in reading and math; and
- Reduction of student discipline incidents and improved school climate.

SIA Plan investments are to focus on the following areas of:

- ♦ Class size
- ♦ Well-rounded education
- ♦ Instructional time
- ♦ Health and Safety

Michelle described the strategies to be utilized for each individual investment area. The Student Success Act Roadmap was reviewed as well.

The School Board acted to approve the proposed plan as required by the Oregon Department of Education. Michelle will now proceed with submitting our plan to ODE. Any suggested edits from the state will be incorporated, and a final version will be brought back to the Board for their consideration prior to funding that is expected to become available in July 2020.

Policy JEBA: Admission to Kindergarten and First Grade, was approved for First Reading.

Policy JHFE: Reporting of Suspected Abuse of a Child, was approved for First Reading.
