He commended the Board for their vision in making key investments in our schools to support safety and he remains committed to our vision of the future of our schools and community. Fremont Middle School will be receiving a \$2.5 million Seismic grant to rehabilitate

the gymnasium and multi-purpose rooms to life safety and immediate occupancy standards that will enable us to use the space as community emergency shelters. Jill Weber and her staff have done amazing work skillfully planning our Class of 2020 graduation celebration. A resurrected old bus will be serving as an additional Lunchbox Express on neighborhood routes. Safety Coordinator, Ed Villarreal has applied for a COPS Grant to support District-wide visitor ID and additional fencing. The Superintendent assured the Board of his confidence that we will have a plan to support students, families and community next year.

Revised Policies Presented for 2nd Reading/Adoption

Human Resources Director, Robert Freeman, shared Policy JHFE-AR: Reporting of Suspected Abuse of a Child, to accompany Policy JHFE.

Teaching and Learning Director, Michelle Knee, also presented revised TAG policies as follows:

Policy IGBB: Talented and Gifted Program;

Policy IGGBA: Talented and Gifted Students-Identification;

Policy IGGBA-AR: Appeal Procedure for Talented and Gifted Student Identification and Placement; and

Policy IGBBC: Talented and Gifted — Programs and Services.

The Board approved all of the above policies and associated ARs for Second Reading and Adoption.

Adoption of Elementary Math Instructional Materials

Teaching and Learning Director, Michelle Knee, reported that a group of pilot teachers worked since last fall and unanimously decided to select Ready Classroom Mathematics for a 6-year math adoption. The overall cost of \$455,600 will include both student and teacher materials, online access and continued access to the iReady diagnostic and instructional piece already being utilized. The Board was pleased to approve this recommendation.

School Resource Officer (SRO) Intergovernmental Agreement

The Board approved the 2020-2021 School Resource Officer (SRO) Agreement between the District and the City of Roseburg in the amount of \$150,000. Board Chairman Joe Garcia acknowledged that this has been a great partnership and he thanked the City for their willingness to pick up a portion of the cost of this valued program.

Board Member Resignation

Chairman Joseph Garcia announced his decision to resign from the Board effective immediately. Board and community members acknowledged Joe's steadfast commitment to all students of RPS since his appointment in 2008. We all sincerely wish you nothing but the best, Joe!
